Position

Purpose

The Torch of Gold is a council-level distinguished award of the Boy Scouts of America to recogniz service and leadership working with Scouts who have disabilities.

Guidelines

Name

- Each council may recognize one Scouter per year with the Torch of Gold Award.
- Completed nomination form must be submitted to the council Special Needs or Disabilitie committee, or its designee, according to council procedures and deadline.
- The nominee shall:
 - a. Be currently registered with the Boy Scouts of America.
 - b. Have a least three years of service in any Scouting leadership capacity related to Scouts BSA, Venturers and/or Sea Scouts with disabilities, including educating of about disabilities and working with youth who have disabilities.
 - c. Have completed all activities related to Scouts with disabilities on a strictly volunt
- A Scouter may only receive this award once.
- Presentation should be made at the council annual recognition dinner, district recognition or appropriate Scouting event.
- The Scout Executive must approve the recipient.
