THE EVIDENCE Scouting Develops Character

Does Scouting make a difference?

A comprehensive three-year study by Tufts University followed nearly 1,800 Cub Scouts and 400 non-Scouts under age 12 to examine character development in real time.

At the beginning, there were no significant differences between the two groups. But by the end of the study, the results were unmistakable. Scouts showed measurable growth in:

- Cheerfulness
- Helpfulness
- Obedience
- Kindness
- Hopefulness
- Trustworthiness

These are the building blocks of strong character—and Scouting delivers them.
